PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

ABR[®] **Deck & Siding Wash** is a versatile one step deck cleaner designed to remove surface dirt and paint oxidation from painted and non-painted surfaces.

This versatile product cleans wood decks, log homes & wood sidewalls. ABR[®] Deck & Siding Wash is compatible with pressure washers and steam cleaners, yet can be used when washing by hand and followed with a garden hose rinse. The product works with both hot and cold water, is biodegradable; contains no phosphates, caustics, or acids; and will

not etch glass. **ABR® Deck & Siding Wash** is ideal for periodic use, whenever deck surfaces require cleaning.

Limitations: ABR® Deck & Siding Wash will not remove any paint, stain or clear finish that is in sound condition. ABR® Deck & Siding Wash may dull painted and metal surfaces if it is not rinsed off quickly. **ABR**[•] **Deck & Siding Wash** will not bring back a natural wood color to pressure treated green lumber since its color was previously lost in the original treatment of the wood.

Precautions: read the entire Material Safety Data Sheet and product label for a more thorough evaluation of hazards. Beware of wind drift onto auto and pedestrian traffic when rinsing or applying **ABR* Deck & Siding Wash**. Fully protect all adjacent surfaces. Do not allow **ABR* Deck & Siding Wash** to splash or dry onto adjacent surfaces. Immediately rinse with water any surface the residue comes in contact with. Unlike bleach and detergents, **ABR* Deck & Siding Wash** is not considered a strong defoliant. However the use of breathing types of drop cloths to protect delicate and/or adjacent vegetation is recommended.

TECHNICAL DATA

Color/Form: clear liquid.

Coverage: 300 sq. ft. per gallon when used up to 1:10 dilution.

Note: coverage will also vary depending on the porosity of wood. Rough sawn wood will require more **ABR® Deck & Siding Wash** than smooth wood.

Packaging: quarts, one, five and fifty-five gallon containers.

INSTALLATION

Preparatory Work: thoroughly sweep surface to be cleaned. A test area should be cleaned prior to beginning overall project to determine precise procedures necessary for most effective cleaning. Test area should be processed on each type of surface before overall cleaning. Allow test areas to dry thoroughly before determining results.

Adjust the strength based on the test results. User shall determine the suitability of the product for its intended use and assumes all risk and liability whatsoever in connection therewith.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. To avoid streaking, always pre-wet the surface to be cleaned.

2. Spray **ABR**[®] **Deck & Siding Wash** on to the surface or apply with a long-

handled brush or broom. (ABR[®] Deck & Siding Wash may be used up to 1 part ABR[®] Deck & Siding Wash to 10 parts water for light cleaning or use with brushing.)

3. All surfaces should be thoroughly rinsed with clean water.

4. For best results on a vertical surface, apply **ABR® Deck & Siding Wash** from the bottom up and pressure rinse from the bottom up. Final rinse starting from the top down.

6. For deck surfaces, use **ABR**^{*} **Deck & Siding Wash** with a low pressure water rinse. For best results, rinse with a pressure washer. Hold the pressure washer nozzle about 12" from the surface being rinsed.

Note: on smooth, new decking lumber, remove mill glaze by using X-180 Weathered Wood Restorer[™]. Please see the X-180 Weathered Wood Restorer[™] specification sheet for instructions.

Caution: ABR[®] Deck & Siding Wash is slippery when applied to horizontal surface. Use caution when washing surface, especially roofs.

Clean up: water flush shrubbery, sidewalks, blacktop, asphalt, equipment and all adjacent surfaces immediately upon contact.

MAINTENANCE

To protect newly restored wood from ultra-violet damage, moisture, and fungus growth, follow up the ABR[®] Deck & Siding Wash cleaning process with the appropriate X-100 Natural Seal[®] product. Wood must be completely dry after the application of ABR[®] Deck & Siding Wash.
