A Little Wkinsy in the Wood



There's a charm of nature already intrinsic to wood structures, but we get an extra smile when there's a little whimsy added with bear carvings added to a log post, an eagle in a ridge pole, or art woven into cedar shakes, as we've seen examples about on Pinterest. When redoing our storefront, there was a bare face under the entry roof that begged for something not boring. With leftover (local white cedar) shakes from the roof, we thought we'd take a risk with some creative


liberty and take a stab at shake art. Across the road the cattails are ringing all summer with red-winged blackbirds, and so that was the chosen subject to tie the building into its natural surroundings.

DID YOU KNOW?

Do You Need A Lock Sock?

An old wool sock can save outdoor pad locks from freezing up due to freezing rain and snow. The wool wicks away the moisture and allows it to dissipate away from the inside of the lock. After hearing about this and trying it for a season, it works! The key is to use a wool sock, not a cotton one.

The distinguishing

feature is its short handle relative to the size of its head. It is extremely practical to carry in your rucksack on forest walks, or to keep in the car as it takes up very little space. The shape of the sheath, which covers the edge and the top part of the poll, also stops the axe head cutting into your rucksack. An excellent scouting and camping axe. DID YOU KNOW?
